



Woodland Birds for Biodiversity field day, Mitchellstown, Nagambie

Our **Woodland Birds** are in trouble! Over the past 12 years, research has indicated that there has been a **66%** decline of the bird species recorded in Victoria's Box-Ironbark Forests and Woodlands.



To help reverse the decline of these woodland birds, Trust for Nature and Birdlife Australia have been working together with private landowners to protect remnant vegetation in perpetuity. This project was funded through the Australian Government's Caring for our Country initiative.

Just past Punt Rd, turn left into Delaneys Rd. Follow for 2.9km from corner to the white front gate. Property is on the left. Vic Roads Map reference 46 B7.
