The Yea Wetlands Committee is proud to present another Special Evening with Guest Speaker, Ron Litjens. This time Ron will talk about Rakali, the Australian White Tailed Water Rat.

Those who attended our night on the Powerful Owl will recall Ron as the speaker who impressed everyone with his engaging knowledge and passion.

A member of the Strath Creek Landcare Group and the Platypus Conservancy and foundation member of the King Parrot Creek Environment Group, Ron co-writes blogs for both the Focus on Fauna project and the King Parrot Creek Environment Group. Cheekily, he considers himself a 'citizen scientist'.

The Rakali, is one of only two semi-aquatic mammals in Australia – the other being the better known platypus. Once hunted for their fur, the Rakali is now protected and consequently more commonly found living near permanent bodies of fresh and salt water. They are elusive creatures. Very often all you will see is the flash of its white-tipped tail as it disappears from view. Ron will amaze us with the story of the Rakali living in a dam in Flowerdale.
